£90 for social walking


Catering: Full catered.

Do you want to be able to take your girls on adventures outside? From nature trails to hillwalking, this weekend is for you.

Join us for: level 1 and the water safety module, level 2 training or assessment, or for log book walks/social walking



Who's it for?: Members aged 16+

For level 1, participants need to be able to walk at a gentle pace for approximately 3 hours each day on paths in lowland areas. For level 2, participants need to be able to walk in hilly terrain, sometimes off path for 5 hours on Saturday plus 2 hours night navigation and then 3 hours on Sunday.

What is it?: Training will be facilitated in small groups of

up to six people, with a relaxed and friendly atmosphere. There will be some online



training in advance of the courses.

Travel: Own travel – we suggest lift sharing and will help facilitate that where possible.
