Items needed: a marshmallow, a malteser, 3 white chocolate buttons, a cupcake case and a few extra chocolate buttons melted in the microwave

Place the marshmallow wide end down in a pool of melted chocolate in a cupcake case.

Dip the malteser in the melted chocolate and place on the narrower end of the marshmallow.

Stick the 2 small chocolate buttons on the back of the marshmallow for wings. Stick 1 chocolate button on the malteser for the halo.
