



Venue (Outdoor) Risk Assessment – Hertfordshire Guide Centre

Description: Hertfordshire Guide Centre is located in the village of Cottered. It offers indoor accommodation, a campsite, pond, and campfire circle. It is suitable for meetings, trainings, sleepovers, camps, pond dipping sessions and campfires. It can also be used for Duke of Edinburgh expeditions.

Intended outcomes: Enjoyment, community, performing, and fun.

Leaders are responsible for reviewing and amending the risk assessment with considerations for their unit. It is recommended that this be completed during a site visit and subsequently shared with the leadership Team. Individual risk assessments are available for each activity.
